Norm Fasteners acquired an automotive fastener manufacturing operation in Plymouth, MI, USA, adding local production to its established North American sales, engineering, logistics and warehousing capabilities. The site includes a 121,000 ft² manufacturing facility on 9.4 acres and manufacturing assets. The operation produces high-strength automotive bolts with processes including cold forming, heat treatment, thread-rolling, sorting and packaging.



Norm has operated in Michigan since 2018 and maintained its regional sales, engineering, logistics and warehousing center in Lansing, MI, USA since 2019. The Plymouth facility results in an integrated North American hub.

"The Plymouth acquisition is an important step in our journey to become a truly global fastener manufacturer. As we strengthen our manufacturing capabilities across different regions, we are building a structure that enables us to respond more quickly to the needs and expectations of customers in more than 50 countries," commented **Nedim Uysal**, Vice Chairperson of **Norm Holding**.

GE Appliances, a **Haier** company, and the **IUE-CWA** announced a major transformation of Appliance Park, Louisville, KY, USA, with a US\$1 billion investment by GE to expand high-output production of laundry products and reinforce its long-term commitment to manufacturing in Kentucky and the USA. With new and expanded production across Buildings 1, 2 and 5, the investment will establish Appliance Park as America's largest home appliance manufacturing site, reflecting its scale across production output, employment and campus footprint.

As part of the plans, GE Appliances will invest more than US\$400 million to transform Building 5 into a high-output manufacturing operation for dryers, bringing production from Mexico to Kentucky. Investment of approximately US\$112 million in Building 1 will add new equipment and redesign existing washer and dryer platforms. And this latest investment by GE Appliances will continue the previously announced US\$490 million investment in Building 2 to produce frontload washers and Combo washer/dryers that begin production in 2027. 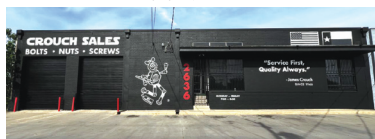

FDI Falls to 58.3 & FLI Falls to 56.9

The FDI remained strong, but moderated last month, reading 58.3, after its 59.9 reading in July, seasonally adjusted. The Forward Looking Indicator (FLI) remained firmly in positive territory, but also dropped slightly to 56.9 after its euphoric 61.6 reading the previous month. Henkel: Strong sales & earnings in 1st half; upgraded top-line guidance for 2026

Henkel Group sales in the first half of the year saw a strong organic growth of 3.2%, reaching €10.3 billion. This strong growth was underpinned by positive price and volume dynamics across the company's business units.



The company's operating profit (EBIT) increased to €1620 million for a +0.3% increase. A strong EBIT margin of 15.7% (+10 basis points), was supported by both business units, demonstrating the strength of businesses.

Earnings per preferred share (EPS) increased to €2.86 euros, up 7.1 % at constant exchange rates. This growth came from the successful execution of the M&A growth strategy in the first half of the year, with first positive sales and earnings contributions in 2026.

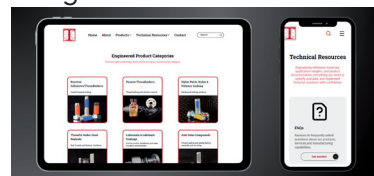

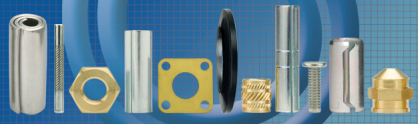
